- **Physical Therapy Program** - Specialists in activity, exercise and rehabilitation.
- **Ultrasound Program** - Specialists in disorders of the bones and joints.
- **Psychosocial Counseling** - Individual and family counseling offered.
- **Social Work Services** - Connects patients to available resources while providing assistance to patients and caregivers with issues of daily living, acceptance and adjusting to hemophilia.
- **Infusion 101 Workshops** - Specialists who assist you and/or your child in learning how to infuse.
- **340B Factor Program** - The most cost effective, prescription medicine and the highest quality medical care for you and your family.
- **Current Education and Publications** - Education to medical professionals, patients and families (i.e. bilingual children's books, The X-File Bilingual Newsletter, and more!)
- **Clinical Research Program** - Clinical research trials including new treatment options and gene therapy for hemophilia
- **Thrombosis Program** - Specialists who assist children with thrombotic disorders including access to clinical trials.
- **Dental Program** - Need based program that provides eligible participants access to Board Certified Dentists, Periodontists, and Oral Surgeons who are experts in treating children and adults with bleeding disorders.
- **Education Dinners and Programs** - Fun and exciting opportunities for learning and interaction with the bleeding disorders community.
- **Orthotics Program** - Need based program that provides eligible patients custom made orthotics which help improve the alignment of the foot and decrease the incidence of joint bleeds.

A 340B factor program is available to eligible patients, resulting in lowered cost to third party payers for the expensive clotting factor concentrates required to treat many of these disorders. Our clinical 340B program coordinator is available to help in making ordering your factor and establishing monthly home delivery of your prescribed concentrate, a stress free task.

Monthly comprehensive bleeding disorder clinics provide the patient with an evaluation by physicians, specialized nursing staff, physical therapist, orthopaedics and psychosocial worker in one convenient location.
